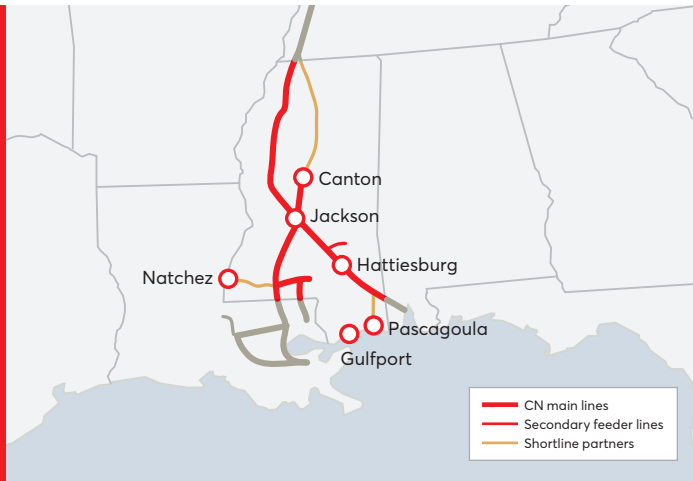

CN's network criss-crosses Mississippi, with a rail yard in Jackson serving as a hub for petroleum headed to the western part of the Magnolia State, coal moving east to Alabama, grain shipping south to the Gulf Coast for export, and chemical products headed north to the Midwest. Intermodal products destined throughout North America are handled through our intermodal terminal in Jackson. Amtrak's *City of New Orleans* service stops in Jackson at CN's rail yard. CN also has an automotive distribution facility serving the Nissan assembly plant in Canton.

## Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested more than US\$600 million to build and maintain a safe and efficient network in Mississippi and to support our supply chain partners. The program focused on the replacement of rail and ties, as well as maintenance of bridges, public crossings, culverts, signal systems and other track infrastructure.

## Community Partnerships

In 2022, CN contributed to several Mississippi-based organizations, including:

**AMERICAN RED CROSS** CN helped support residents of Jackson impacted by a severe water crisis by donating to the Jackson chapter of the American Red Cross. We also sent bottled water and personal hygiene supplies to help people who could not safely use city-supplied water.

**AMERICA IN BLOOM** CN *EcoConnexions* contributed to America in Bloom to promote beautification in Madison by planting trees and shrubs.

**HUNGER2HOPE** Hunger2Hope is a non-profit organization in DeSoto County that provides nutritional, emotional, and spiritual support to students whose families are facing hard times. Each weekend during the school year, qualifying students are given a backpack filled with food for each meal during the weekend and encouragement to keep them uplifted for the week to come.

**MISSISSIPPI URBAN LEAGUE** The Mississippi Urban League works to create sustainable pathways to health equity, improved educational outcomes, and economic empowerment to elevate the standard of living for those Mississippians residing in historically underserved communities.
