

CN Optional Services **Intermodal** Changes for 2012

CN 9100 and CN 6800 – Effective January 1, 2012

Overview

We have been listening to our customers and through working with you, have improved the ease of doing business at our intermodal terminals by increasing gate hours in Edmonton, AB, Calgary, AB, Moncton, NB and Detroit, MI. We are opening a new facility in Chippewa Falls, WI this October, as well as a new container yard and transload facility in Vancouver, BC this November. Our Prince George, BC facility will expand from 400 to 700 FEUs per week transloading capability in January 2012 allowing our Forest Products customers to benefit from overseas demand for lumber.
