Go team!

Indoors or outdoors, Balloon Stomp is a fun game!

You'll need two balloons for each player, with different colours for each team, and about 46 cm (18") of yarn or ribbon for each balloon.

Choose teams, with an equal number of players on each team. Each player needs to blow up their balloons, knot the ends and tie on the yarn or ribbon, then tie the other end around each of their ankles.

Mark out boundaries for the play area. Ready? Ask someone to yell "GO" and start



stomping to pop the opposing team's balloons! No, you can't use your hands! As soon as a player has had both their balloons popped, they need to move outside the play area.

The team with a player who has at least one balloon that's not popped wins.
