Primary Responsibilities

- Conduct fundamental research to identify investment opportunities
- Perform detailed company analysis including building financial projection models on securities owned or under consideration as an investment
- Conduct management interviews and establish relationships with senior management of companies under their areas of responsibility
- Develop investment thesis and present recommendations to the portfolio manager and research team
- Monitor companies within the portfolio to assess how the investment thesis is playing out and re-evaluate recommendations proactively according to conviction levels
