CN's main line from the Detroit area to our primary U.S. hub in Chicago passes through the northwest corner of Indiana. While the number of route miles CN operates in Indiana is relatively small, the impact of the state could not be more significant. Gary is home to Kirk Yard, CN's largest rail yard in the United States and one of only two CN hump yards in the country. The intermodal terminal in Indianapolis links directly to CN's expansive continental network via our partnership with Indiana Railroad.

## Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested about US\$240 million to build and maintain a safe and efficient network in Indiana and to support our supply chain partners. The program focused on upgrades to Kirk Yard, the replacement of rail and ties, plus maintenance of bridges, crossings, culverts, signal systems, and other track infrastructure.

## Community Investments

In 2024, CN contributed to several Indiana-based organizations, including:

**DRESSED FOR SCHOOL** In Porter County, one in three students are from families experiencing financial difficulties. Dressed for School helps these children have the same opportunities to attend school with confidence and social acceptance in quality, well-fitting clothes at no cost. CN donated to purchase 100 pairs of new gym shoes.

**FOOD BANK OF NORTHWEST INDIANA** The Food Bank of Northwest Indiana has been leading the region's fight against food insecurity by distributing approximately 6 million meals each year to hungry kids, adults and seniors across Lake and Porter counties.

**PORTAGE RECOVERY ASSOCIATION** Through activities such as meetings, fellowship, and educational and social events, PRA strives to enhance the lives of people recovering from addiction. CN supports PRA's Next Chapter Café, a first-of-its-kind hybrid hangout for members of the recovering community, their family and friends, and residents of Portage and surrounding areas.

**MULTI-AGENCY ACADEMIC COOPERATIVE FOUNDATION** First Responder Appreciation and Demonstration Day has become a premier event in Porter County, with over 6,000 attendees. This family-friendly event pays tribute to the commitment, courage and sacrifice of first responders. Once again, CN was a Platinum Sponsor with Little Obie in attendance.

**DYER POLICE DEPARTMENT** The Dyer Police Department provides policing and community services to the community. The DPD Drone Program enhances public safety, officer safety, and investigative effectiveness/efficiency. CN contributed to the purchase a drone equipped with thermal-imaging cameras designed to assist with the overwatch of a scene, search and rescue, natural disasters, high-risk incidents, etc.

**AMERICA IN BLOOM** As part of our *EcoConnexions From the Ground Up* program, CN partnered with America in Bloom to promote beautification in Hobart by planting trees.
