CN's network criss-crosses Mississippi, with a rail yard in Jackson serving as a hub for petroleum headed to the western part of the Magnolia State, coal moving east to Alabama, grain shipping south to the Gulf Coast for export, and chemical products headed north to the Midwest. Intermodal products destined throughout North America are handled through our intermodal terminal in Jackson, where more than 350 CN railroaders live and work. Amtrak's *City of New Orleans* service stops in Jackson at CN's rail yard. CN also has an automotive distribution facility serving the Nissan assembly plant in Canton.

Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested more than US\$750 million to build and maintain a safe and efficient network in Mississippi and to support our supply chain partners. The program focused on the replacement of rail and ties, as well as maintenance of bridges, crossings, culverts, signal systems and other track infrastructure.

Community Investments

In 2024, CN contributed to several Mississippi-based organizations, including:

ENON FIRE DEPARTMENT EFD offers firefighting services, including structure and wildfires, along with emergency medical services, including trauma response, general medical response, wellness checks and lifting assistance calls. CN funded the purchase of four refurbished automated external defibrillators (AEDs) for use by first responders.

MISSISSIPPI'S TOUGHEST KIDS CN supported Camp Kamassa, a year-round camp designed and built especially for children and adults with special needs.

REVITALIZE MISSISSIPPI Revitalize Mississippi works in neighborhoods most impacted by abandoned properties and disinvestment by cleaning up properties and improving community assets, such as parks. For example, Revitalize Mississippi is working with the City of Jackson to improve Livingston Park in West Jackson. CN is supporting the effort by helping to fix the fence that surrounds it.

SOUL CITY WORKS Serving the City of Jackson, Soul City Works creates jobs and affordable housing by renovating abandoned houses and other facilities in the neighborhood and making them useful for the residents again. CN donated to the renovation of the Midtown Swimming Pool. As a result, local crime rates are dropping as people now have opportunities for recreation in positive ways.

WALLS VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT It is the mission of the Walls Fire Department to protect all citizens from injury and loss through fire prevention, fire suppression, rescue operations, and emergency medical services. CN helped establish a training facility to service the local fire department and community as well as surrounding fire departments by providing a safe site to better train and equip the volunteers.

AMERICA IN BLOOM As part of our *EcoConnexions From the Ground Up* program, CN partnered with America in Bloom to promote beautification in Hazlehurst and Madison by planting trees, shrubs and groundcovers.
